PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed and absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call poison control center, or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS. This product is a mild reducer! Keep away from strong oxidizing agents such as sodium hypochlorite bleach and chlorine tablets for swimming pools.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wear chemical resistant gloves when handling this product. Before draining a treated pool, spa, or hot tub, contact your local sanitary sewer and storm drain authorities and follow their discharge instructions. Do not discharge treated pool, spa, or hot tub, water to any location that flows to a gutter or storm drain or natural water body unless discharge is allowed by state and local authorities.

This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae must be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.

Subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools and hot tubs having just visible signs of algae growth require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of freshly cleaned spas, whirlpools or hot tub, add initially 0.6 to 1.1 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of this product must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

FOR WINTER ALGAE CONTROL: This product will prevent the growth of most algae during the off season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 6 ½ to 13 ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools having some visible algae growth at the end of the swimming season, add 13 to 19 ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. Distribute this product uniformly throughout the pool to ensure maximum effectiveness. If the pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Keep this product dry in its tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep away from heat or open flame. **Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain. Offer for recycling if available.
